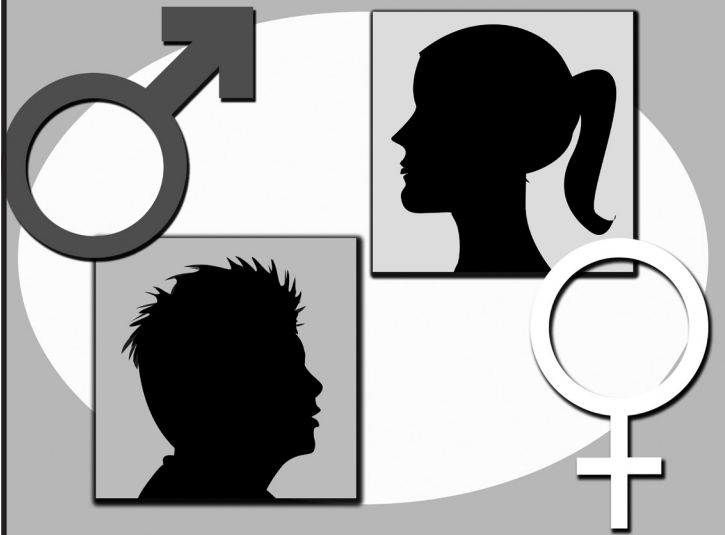

What impact can religion have on women?

October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

Survivors of cults and domestic violence will explore religious teachings that can expose women to higher rates of abuse as well as Religious Trauma Syndrome. They will share their stories of how they found freedom after escaping religion and abuse.

Religion is a personal and widespread experience in the lives of most women. However, some sects promote male dominance with beliefs such as, "Wives be subject to your husbands as you are to the Lord," thereby, giving license to domestic abuse. Such practices continue today with a profound impact on many women's emotional, psychological, social, and economic well-being.
